

#### TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME:

#### Greetings

Whereas, it having been duly represented to us that the members of the United Architects of the Philippines, presently residing/working in the Southern Area of the State of CALIFORNIA, USA, within our jurisdiction, have heretofore, to wit: on November 09, 2010, received the endorsement by their District Director to assemble as a Chapter, for the purpose expressed in their Petition;

AND WHEREAS, it having been further represented that the said members are now desirous that their Chapter shall be duly chartered as a regular Chapter; and it appearing, after due examination, that they are well qualified and in all respect worthy to assume and fulfill the duties consequent upon the indulgence of their said desire:

AND WHEREAS it being believed that the advancement of Architecture will be encouraged, and the just, moral and beneficent purposes of our association be promoted by the establishment of their Chapter;

Now, THEREFORE, KNOW YOU, that we, the National Board of Directors, have authorized and appointed, and by this our CHARTER, do hereby authorize and appoint all as such lawful members as have already been or may hereafter admitted to associate, assemble and work as a regular Chapter, at the aforesaid locality in, by the name and designation of

#### **UAP SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA CHAPTER** (Chapter Registration No.130)

AND WE DO HEREBY GRANT to the officers and their successors and to the members of the Chapter, full power and authority to receive and admit qualified registered to membership; to elect their officers, annually; to exact from their members such fees and dues as may be necessary for the maintenance of their Chapter and for the regular payment of such fees and dues to the National Office as shall by it be directed; and generally, to perform and do all other acts and things which shall be in full accordance with, and in strict obedience to the Constitution and By-Laws of this, our association, the United Architects of the Philippines.

AND WE DO HEREBY REQUIRE the said Chapter to attend all national meetings, conferences and conventions, by its officers or by its representatives, duly appointed; to keep a fair and faithful record of all its acts and proceedings which are proper to be written; and to submit the same to the National Office as directed.

AND LASTLY, WE DO HEREBY ENJOIN upon the officers of the Chapter, aforesaid, that they ever observe a strict conformity to all the policies, regulations and circulars of our association.

ISSUED BY THE NATIONAL BOARD OF DIRECTORS in accordance with policies and the Constitution and By-laws in Quezon City, Philippines, on April 26, 2011.



Warm greetings to everyone! Year 2021 is a significant year as we celebrate our Ten-Year Anniversary, a big achievement for all of us. It is a celebration for all who have been a part of the United Architects of the Philippines Southern California Chapter.

Ten years ago, in 2011, the birth of the United Architects of the Philippines Southern California Chapter came to life.

After the founding of UAP CAL116 (based in Northern California) in 2008, and under the leadership of the late Arch. Eduardo Quezon, a vision to reach Filipino architects based in Southern California became one of the first goals. They realized a separate and independent chapter in Southern California would best meet the needs of colleagues in the area.

The move would also be beneficial for those who resided in Southern California and were holding positions of responsibilities with the Northern California Chapter. It allowed them to be more effective in the service and pursuit of the UAP's mission and aspirations.

A small group of Filipino architects based all over Southern California started hosting gatherings throughout the Los Angeles area. These meetings captured the interest of more Filipino architects, and as a consequence, the UAP SoCal Chapter was formally established. Throughout that time, UAP CAL116 was very supportive and engaged, travelling to Southern California, participating in a few of the general membership meetings.

On January 31, 2011, UAP CAL116 issued to us their board resolution number 01 series of 2010-2011, a resolution sponsoring the creation of an independent Southern California Chapter. With this and together with other pertinent documents, our application was submitted to the UAP National Board of Directors through the National Committee on Chapter Organization on February 01, 2011.

After a laborious process of preparing and completing all requirements, the formation of the United Architects of the Philippines Southern California Chapter was formally granted by the United Architects of the Philippines National Board of Directors on April 26, 2011 with Chapter Registration No. 130. Our chartering and first ever induction of officers and members was held on October 16, 2011 at the Almansor Court in Alhambra, California.

Arch. Emerito Maulion was the first Chapter President of UAP SoCal, as interim during its formation process for Fiscal Year 2010-2011, and upon chartering as the first inducted President during Fiscal Year 2011-2012. He was supported and assisted by the following chapter officers: Arch. Leilanie Pekson Panyawai, Vice-President for Programs and Development; Arch. Teofilo Cotangco;, Vice-President for Operations;

# IN MEMORIAM ARCH. ROGER LAYM JAP (1941-2018)

"Ka Roger" as he is fondly called by colleagues was of slim built who wore a big smile always. He loved playing with the drums, dancing and listening to music and partying.

A professional architect from the Philippines, he immigrated to the United States in the 1970's. He got his California Architect license in 1980 and worked as an expatriate Filipino-American working overseas in Hong Kong and China before establishing his freelance practice in the 1990's or thereabout.

His early working experience was with an engineering firm, St. Andrew Structural Engineers and later on with Parsons / Nadel Partnership.

It was in 2000 in Eagle Rock, CA when he and fellow UAP member architects had the vision of establishing a chapter of the United Architects of the Philippines in Southern California to promote the mission in advancing the objectives of the Filipino architects in the US. His leadership quality came to fore when he was elected Chapter President of the chapter aptly named, "United Architects of the Philippines Los Angeles Chapter". The new organization was chartered under the leadership of the National President Anna Mangalino-Ling 2001. Sadly, the Los Angeles Chapter was dissolved due to waning membership interest.

The defunct of the Los Angeles Chapter, found him wanting to join the newlychartered United Architects of the Philippines Southern California Chapter in 2011. He was an active officer and corporate member of the Chapter until he left to start a new life in Iloilo, Philippines.

Architect Layman was a devout Christian and was credited for designing a couple of house of worship. He passed away in January 2018 and left behind two grown up daughters in Los Angeles, CA.



## THE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

UAP Southern California (UAP SoCal) Chapter wanted to find a way to give back to the community and make a meaningful impact in the world of Architecture. With this thought in mind, and many projects considered, the idea of putting up a Scholarship Program was born!

The Chapter's Scholarship Program was initially proposed during the term of Chapter President/CP Joven G. Joaquin, Jr. in Fiscal Year 2019-2020. It was later adopted and further pursued by CP Lucille E. Floresta, the current Chapter President for Fiscal Year 2020-2021. Unanimously approved by the Chapter Board and General Membership, a Scholarship Program Fund Drive was launched in September 2020 in conjunction with the publication of a Yearbook to commemorate the Chapter's Tenth Anniversary on April 26, 2021.

In Fiscal Year 2019-2020, then Chapter Secretary Floresta reached out to Dean Jocelyn R. Lutap of the College of Architecture, Design and the Built Environment (CADBE) of the Polytechnic University of the Philippines (PUP) to explore the possibility of granting academic scholarships to academicallyoutstanding but financially-challenged architecture students. It is worth noting that this University was chosen because it is regarded as the largest state university In the Philippines by student population and where majority of students come from low-income families. They came into an agreement that the screening for potential scholars will be handled by the Office of the College Dean while the final selection of recipients of the program will be determined by the Chapter. Also, the Chapter would raise the much-needed funds and will continue to do so annually, and the recipient would receive scholarship money for tuition fees or course-related expenses. The projected pilot implementation of the program will be this incoming school year 2021-2022.

The members of UAP SoCal believe that in giving generously, we share our blessings, and build the strength and talent in UAP. Our legacy then becomes a cycle of generosity to improve our community and build a stronger and better future for the United Architects of the Philippines.






